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NY Rising Community Reconstruction Program




- Participatory resiliency planning process
- 66 Planning Committees representing 124 storm-impacted communities (Sandy, Irene, Lee)
- \$3-25 million of HUD CDBG-DR funding allotted per community to implement projects proposed in plans





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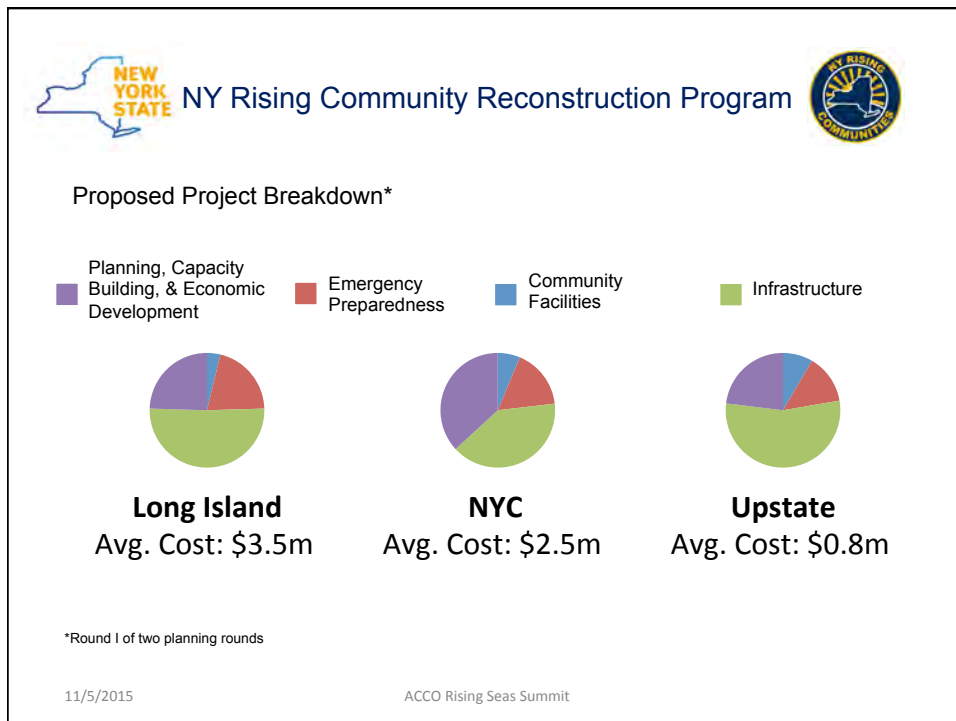
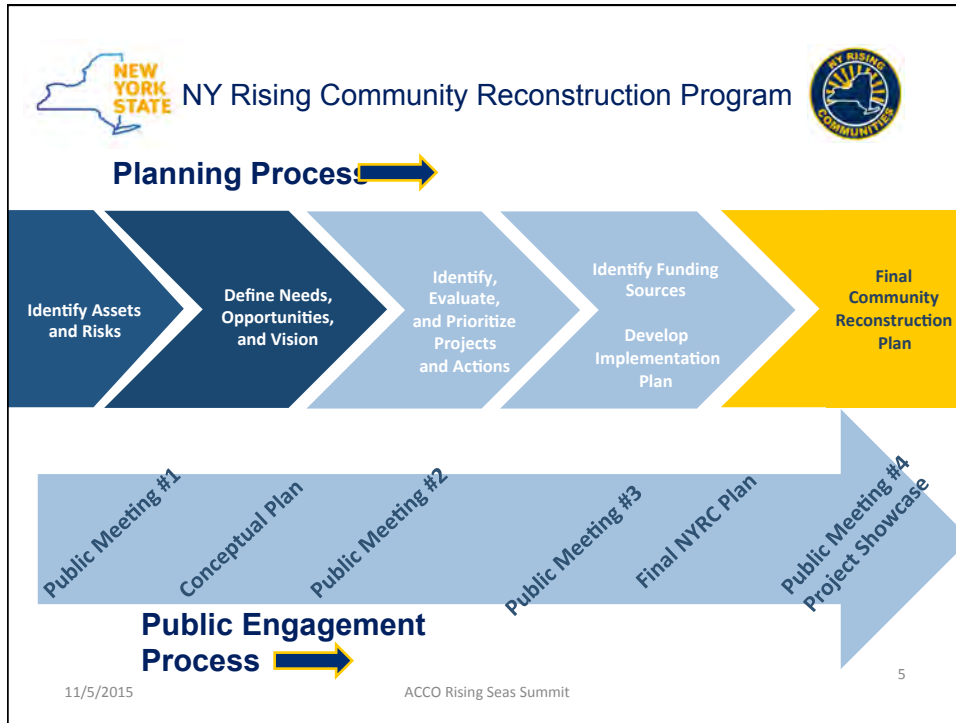


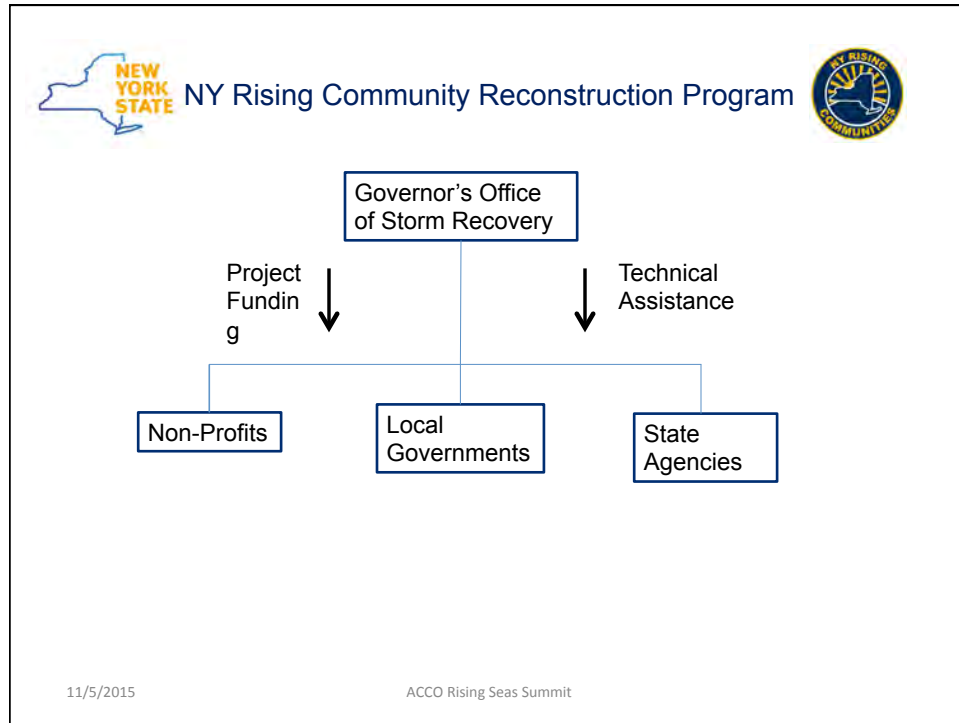


- Planning Committees composed of roughly 10 local residents, civic leaders, business owners, etc.
- Planning process guided by State staff and planning consultants.
- Each Committee held approx. 10 Planning Committee meetings and 4 public engagement events—over 650 committee meetings and 250 public engagement events statewide.

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Implementation Status

- Over 60 subrecipient agreements **entered into** with local partners to implement projects.
- Nearly 160 projects **initiated**. Of this universe, over 120 with preliminary internal approvals. These projects are either in, or will soon move into, the architectural/engineering phase of project development in the case of capital projects, or directly into full implementation in the case of planning and programmatic activities.
- Actively **working to select and initiate** projects to obligate remaining Program funds.

Funding Source: Community Development Block Grant --- Disaster Recovery

- Funded and overseen by U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development
- Grants to states and local governments in the wake of major disasters through special congressional appropriations
- Eligibility requirements conform to regular CDBG rules with the additional requirement that all projects are “tied back” to the declared disaster and with other requirements or waivers issued by HUD Secretary via Federal Register notices.
- Notable focus on resiliency and adaptation in recent years, as evidenced by Rebuild by Design, National Disaster Resilience Competition, etc.

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
